Again a special thank you goes to the eleven Saskatchewan Clubs that helped out over the weekend as well as the many local sponsors.



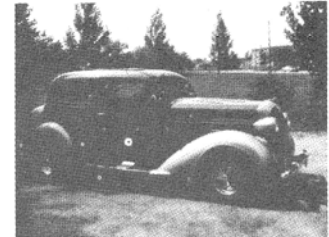

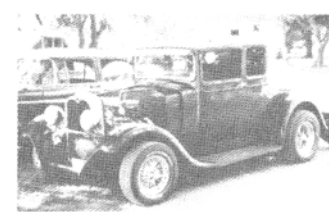

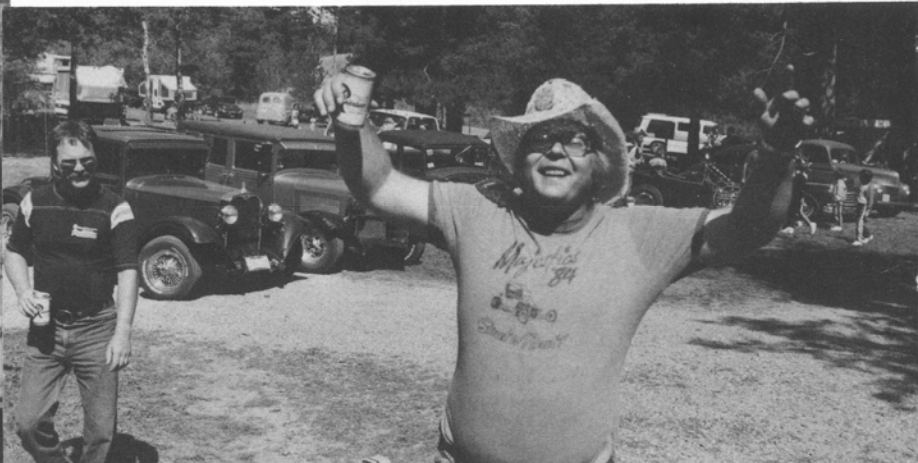
**CSRA Nationals - Sault Ste. Marie**

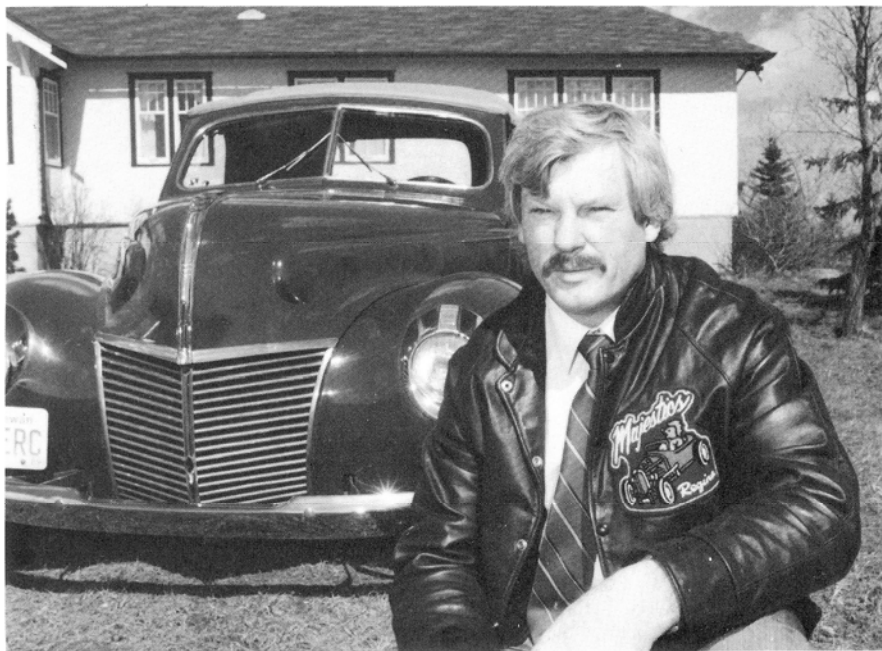

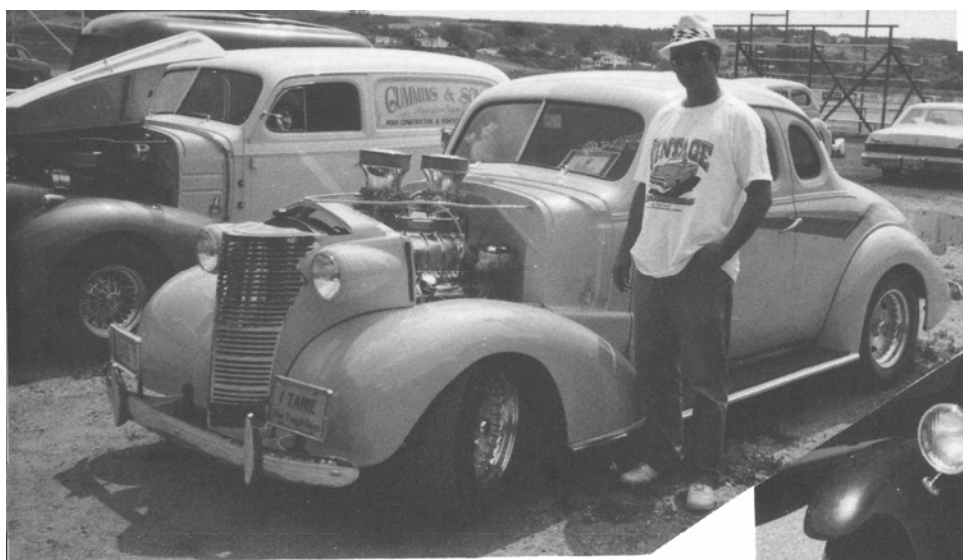

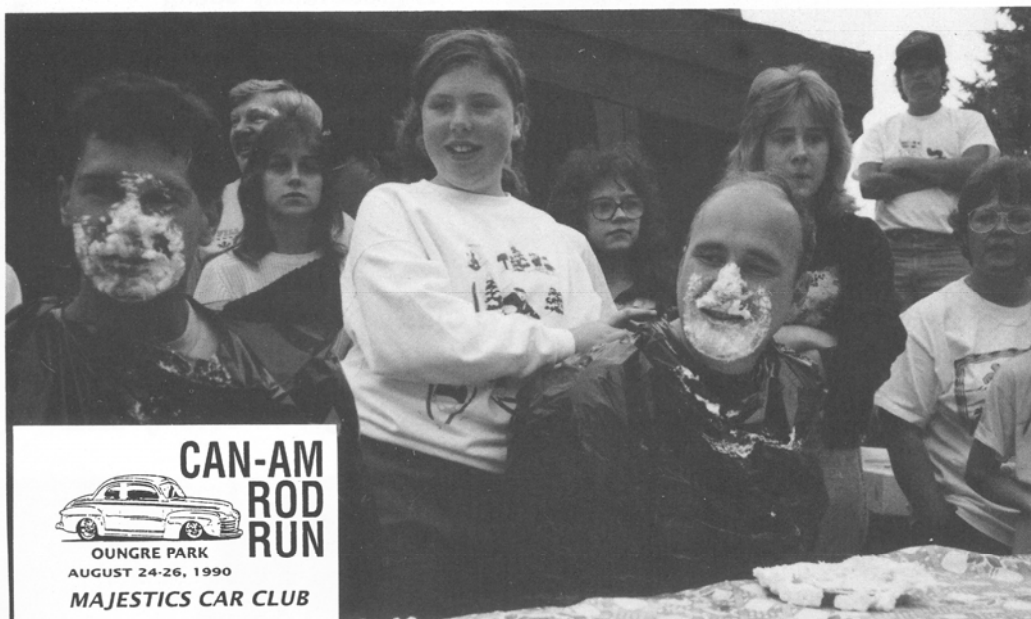
